## **Breath-taking highline show over Copenhagen Harbor at the launch of CPH as architecture Capital of 2023.**

For the first time ever, a group of slackliners will walk a 160-meter line 15 meters above Copenhagen Harbor, connecting the old city (Christianshavn) with the new (BLOX) on a wild highline.

The highline show, which stretches from the terrace of DAC (Danish Architecture Centre) to the old sugar factory on the other side, will take place on May 5th from 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm. There will be seating areas in front of BLOX and on Lille Langebro and Christianshavn side for spectators.

If you want to try walking on the line yourself, you can find the Danish Slackline Association around BLOX, where anyone can try slacklining at street level. There is also an opportunity to join weekly training sessions held every Wednesday – read more at [slacklines.dk](http://slacklines.dk) or their Facebook page.

The breath-taking highline show is part of Architecture Capital 2023 and the opening of Danish Architecture Center's new exhibition 'Copenhagen in Common' (May 5th - October 22nd), which is about Copenhagen and communities.
